



Broadway Boulevard, Euclid to Country Club 2015 Annual Report



Background: The Broadway Boulevard Citizens Planning Task Force was created by Mayor and Council approval of Ordinance 21508 on April 13, 2010. Thirteen members were selected in April 2012, and the first meeting was held on June 20, 2012. By August 30, 2012, the Task Force adopted its own Mission Statement. Both the Mission Statement and Ordinance 21508 identify expected goals of the Citizens Task Force, which the body has achieved (see *Table 1: Broadway Citizens Task Force Planning & Design Accomplishments*). Since June 20, 2012, the Task Force has worked through 38 meetings of the full committee and 5 subcommittee meetings; 1 field trip; 5 large scale community-wide meetings at critical junctures of the project; and 1 public hearing that resulted in the Mayor and Council adopting a Baseline Alignment Concept Map and Technical Design Parameters.

2015 Activities: Seven events were held during 2015 that led to their recommendations to the Mayor and Council regarding the roadway alignment, cross section, and adjacent land uses:

- **March 26, 2015**– *Task Force Meeting to review refinements made to the 6-Lane General Alignment Map approved by the Mayor and Council on October 9, 2014 and RTA Board on December 11, 2012.*
- **March 26, 2015** – *Task Force Meeting to review the Citizens Task Force recommendations for a refined alignment and prepare for the April 23, 2015 Open House.*
- **April 16, 2015** – *Design and Open House Subcommittee Meeting to review the materials and meeting format for the April 23, 2015 Open House.*
- **April 23, 2015** – *Large community-wide Open House providing displays of the Citizens Task Force recommended alignment and initial design parameters.*
- **May 7, 2015** – *Task Force Meeting to review the Task Force recommendations to the Mayor and Council to support the adoption of the Broadway: Euclid to Country Club Baseline Alignment Concept Map and the Technical Design Parameters.*
- **June 9, 2015** – *Mayor and Council Public Hearing resulting in 7-0 vote to approve Resolution 22410, adopting the Baseline Alignment Concept Map and the Technical Design Parameters.*
- **December 10, 2015** – *Task Force Meeting to review the Design Concept Report, to learn about the roadway design progress, hear options regarding the public process and land use planning moving forward.*
